- IV. Provide a Dropbox containing reports/assessments

OUR PROCESS

Methods employed to collect findings:

- ❖ Web-based research
- ❖ Reached out to stakeholders (committee members)
- ❖ Consulted with the CSG

OUR FINDINGS: SPANNING 2010-2024

- ❖ We located **65** reports/assessments total
 - **48** reports, **17** assessments
- ❖ Findings cover a wide range of topics, including:
 - JJ population and demographics
 - Feeders to the JJ system
 - OYA policy compliance
 - Disproportionate contact and representation with(in) the JJ system
 - Evaluations/analysis on JJ system (recommended improvements)
 - Budget notes
- ❖ 64 of the reports/assessments are from government agencies

REPORTS/ASSESSMENTS OVERVIEW

The reports are organized into three categories:

- ❖ County
- ❖ Statewide
- ❖ OYA reports

The summaries are coded by a subject key:

1. Social and Public Services
2. Race and Ethnicity
3. Recommended Improvements

These subjects correlate to Priority 1 and disparities (noted as important to the Commission):

- Key drivers of system involvement.
- Racial, ethnic and other forms of disparities among youth impacted by the juvenile justice system.
- Opportunities for improved diversion and restorative justice.
