

OVERVIEW:

In partnership with Willamette University, Atkinson School of Management, the OPMCP is Oregon state government's premier project management development program. The OPMCP is designed to develop leaders in the project management field. The Oregon Project Management Certification Program (OPMCP) is designed to develop leaders in the project management field. With the complexity of work increasing, our time to complete projects decreasing, and public expectations rising, excellent project management will be key to our future success. This program includes 14 instructor-led classes over a 4 to 5 month period.

The Oregon Project Management Associate (OPMA) certification has been added to Oregon state governments [Project Manager classifications](#) and is equivalent to one year of project management experience. The OPMA certification also counts as one year of experience to meet the minimum qualifications for other classifications/positions that include project management duties such as, but not limited to, Operation and Policy Analyst, Program Analysts, and Information Systems Specialists.
