DAILY PARKING PERMITS (FULL DAY or HALF DAY)

Each numbered daily permit is valid for **ONE DAY ONLY** at the following State parking facilities:

Salem – Any 4-hour State meters, Capitol Mall Parking Structure Lower-Level spaces E24 to E43 and F24 to F43; Yellow, Red and Green lots; and Ferry Street Structure rooftop visitor spaces.

Portland State Office Building park-and-pay spaces in the surface lot.

Half day permits are valid for **FIVE CONSECUTIVE HOURS** only at the same locations.

To use the permit, clearly write in the month and year, and completely fill in the date circle with ink (**not pencil**). For the half-day permits, clearly write in the month, year, and parking start time. Hang the permit from the vehicle's rear-view mirror, with the permit number facing out and clearly visible to allow parking enforcement officers to easily read the information.

Altered or incomplete permits are not valid and are subject to citation. Valid permits that are not properly displayed will also result in a citation for unauthorized parking under Salem revised Code [City of Salem, OR - Code of Ordinances Chapter 102 Sec 105](#). Vehicles displaying daily permits in locations other than those listed above or shown on the map (over), including 30-minute and one-hour State meters, or City of Salem street meters and reserved spaces, could also be cited for unauthorized parking. NOTE: AGENCIES may provide daily permits for Agency/State employees, State board and commission members, or volunteers conducting official State business in Salem and at the Portland State Office Building. They may not sell the permits to employees or to the general public. [ORS 125-090-0075](#)
