Request For Additional Time to Comply with Opportunity to Recycle Requirements

Oregon Administrative Rule 340-090-0630(4)(f) states that a local government may submit a request to DEQ for additional time to meet the obligation to collect materials on the Uniform Statewide Collection List (USCL) for approval, if the local government's ability to successfully collect the materials is dependent on the local government receiving funding for trucks, containers, or a reload facility requested from a producer responsibility organization (PRO) through the 2023 needs assessment, pursuant to ORS 459A.890(8), and the local government has not yet received the funding. To qualify for this rule, your local government must request funding from the PRO in the first program plan period.

If you are a local government that meets the specifications listed above in rule and would like to request additional time to implement the obligations to collect materials on the USCL, please complete the information below and submit completed form to your DEQ Regional Specialist.
