



## Calling all local governments, public education providers and Tribal Nations!

- Do you need help to support local warming or cooling centers?
- Do you need cleaner air spaces the public can use in emergencies?
- Do you need help to upgrade your HVAC smoke filtration system in your public buildings so they can be used as cleaner air spaces?

**Grants and other supports are now available to help** local governments, public education providers, and Tribal Nations provide:

- cleaner air spaces for emergency purposes, such as when wildfire smoke makes breathing difficult
- cooling and warming spaces for when extreme weather creates unhealthy conditions for people

**Grant funds awarded may be used for:**

- initial program startup costs
- purchase and installation of air filtration system improvements
- set up and improvement of warming, cooling and cleaner air spaces

**Good news!** A formal application is not required. Eligible entities will enter into an intergovernmental agreement or interagency agreement with ODHS to receive the grant funding or other supports.
