Interview Summary
Client #1: They have been at the program since the end of May. They think it's a good program but the people suck, they do not like their peers. This is their first program. They really like the staff, Autumn is their favorite and she is very relatable. The food is good, they call it "rich people's food." Clients help with cooking. No one has put their hands on them at the program. They feel safe here and there has never been a time they felt unsafe. They are starting school in 13 days and are very excited. The program takes clients on outings such as hiking. They are hoping to be done with the program in 4 months. Client #2: They have been at the program for five months. They have previously been at two other programs. They love it here. They don't like they only get ½ a muffin and fruit for breakfasts on Sundays. They get enough to eat. They do not like one staff member at the program, they get along with the other clients at the program. They completed summer school and is excited to start school soon. They have regular phone calls with family.

Observations
The program was clean and in good repair. The bedroom doors do not have door knobs, so a magnet system is used to close the bedroom doors. The bedroom doors do not lock.
