Nature of Abuse and Brief Narrative: One allegation of sexual abuse was substantiated after learning a staff member kissed a youth and allowed him to touch her vagina over her clothing. The staff also displayed grooming behaviors leading up to and following this incident, including conversing over social media about sex, purchasing him gifts and spending time with him outside the program.		Corrective Actions Taken or Ordered by the Department, and Outcome: The identified employee was placed on administrative leave when the information about her behavior came to light through a disclosure by a youth in care. She was not permitted to return to work, and her employment was subsequently terminated.

Nature of Abuse and Brief Narrative: One allegation of neglect was substantiated when a staff left a youth unsupervised for over two hours in the classroom. This youth has a history of hospitalization due to suicidal ideation and required a minimum of line-of sight/sight-and-sound supervision.		Corrective Actions Taken or Ordered by the Department, and Outcome: The supervisory employee who made the decision to deviate from the established supervision protocol received coaching from management following the incident. Her employment was subsequently terminated when Morrison Center was informed that the neglect allegation had been substantiated by ODHS. The employee is appealing the neglect finding and has requested a hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings. Immediately following the neglect incident, management reiterated youth supervision expectations for all program personnel. The identified youth was discharged to a higher level of care a few days after the incident. Approximately 1 month later, Morrison Center notified ODHS that it would be permanently closing the site, primarily due to staffing shortages.
