Certification report: Certification report for Aug. 2022 given by Melanie Ewell, Certification Coordinator. No questions or comments were offered following his presentation.

CPR/First Aid report: Kelly Rosenau, Safety Specialist at OHCC, reported on the progress of in-person CPR/First Aid classes that are being offered throughout the state. Kelly stated that it is going well, and she still has vacancies in the classrooms for courses she is scheduling with contracted instructors. In smaller communities with no instructor, she is coordinating with local vendors to provide the service.

PACE Update: Roberta Lilly, Training Manager, reported on the progress that is being made in PACE. Blended model cohorts, such as VDQ and Enhanced Certification are underway in PACE. Additionally, renewal Enhanced Certificates are also underway.

Conferences for training courses: Salem Professional Development Certification (PDC) conference was discussed, as well as the upcoming conference in Pendleton, Oregon. The conferences are created to help providers “jump-start” their PDC coursework as well as receive support from OHCC staff. Next PDC training conferences will be in Coos Bay and Klamath Fall.

Family Caregiver: Course is delayed due to the PACE rollout. It will be started back up for development soon.
