APD-IM-20-131 New Worker Training Series for Homecare and Personal Support Workers

- Training becomes mandatory for all homecare and personal support workers and personal care attendants on Sept. 1, 2021
- Training will be provided by our partner, Carewell SEIU 503 Training.
- Carewell SEIU 503 Training launched a statewide pilot on Dec.1, 2020 for the New Worker Training series.
- Workers hired during the pilot period and who complete the New Worker Training series will not need to take the refresher training for the current workforce when it becomes a requirement in 2021.

APD-IM-20-140 Oregon ACCESS School House Training Environment Limited Functionality



Update: The OA School House training environment is now working with some limitations since there is no connection to the ONE system. Most functionality is working as it should be, except the following:

- Generation of the ONE version of the pay-in worksheet
- The IE/ME Information screen (because there is no connection to the ONE system)

Provider Time Capture – Coming Summer 2021!

- 3 phase roll-out
- Pilot scheduled for August 2021
- Phase 1 implementation scheduled for September 2021
- Currently in the design phase

What is phase one?

Phase one will introduce the system that will bring Oregon in compliance with federal mandates.

Provider Time Capture & OPI

What is required by the mandates?

1. Type of service
2. Consumer getting the service
3. Provider giving the service
4. Date of the service
5. Location of the service
6. Time the service starts and ends

Provider Time Capture & OPI

- Phase one will not reduce workload.
- Hours will still need to be entered and verified by staff.
- The real time saving will come with phase two and automation.

OPI/ONE Updates

- Wave one happened in November 2020
- Wave two is scheduled for February 2021

OPI/ONE Updates: Lessons Learned

- Vouchers can no longer be printed for OSIPM/OPI cases.
- These consumers must choose between OPI and OSIPM.
- **Reminder:** SSI recipients are not eligible for OPI. They can request state plan personal care through APD.

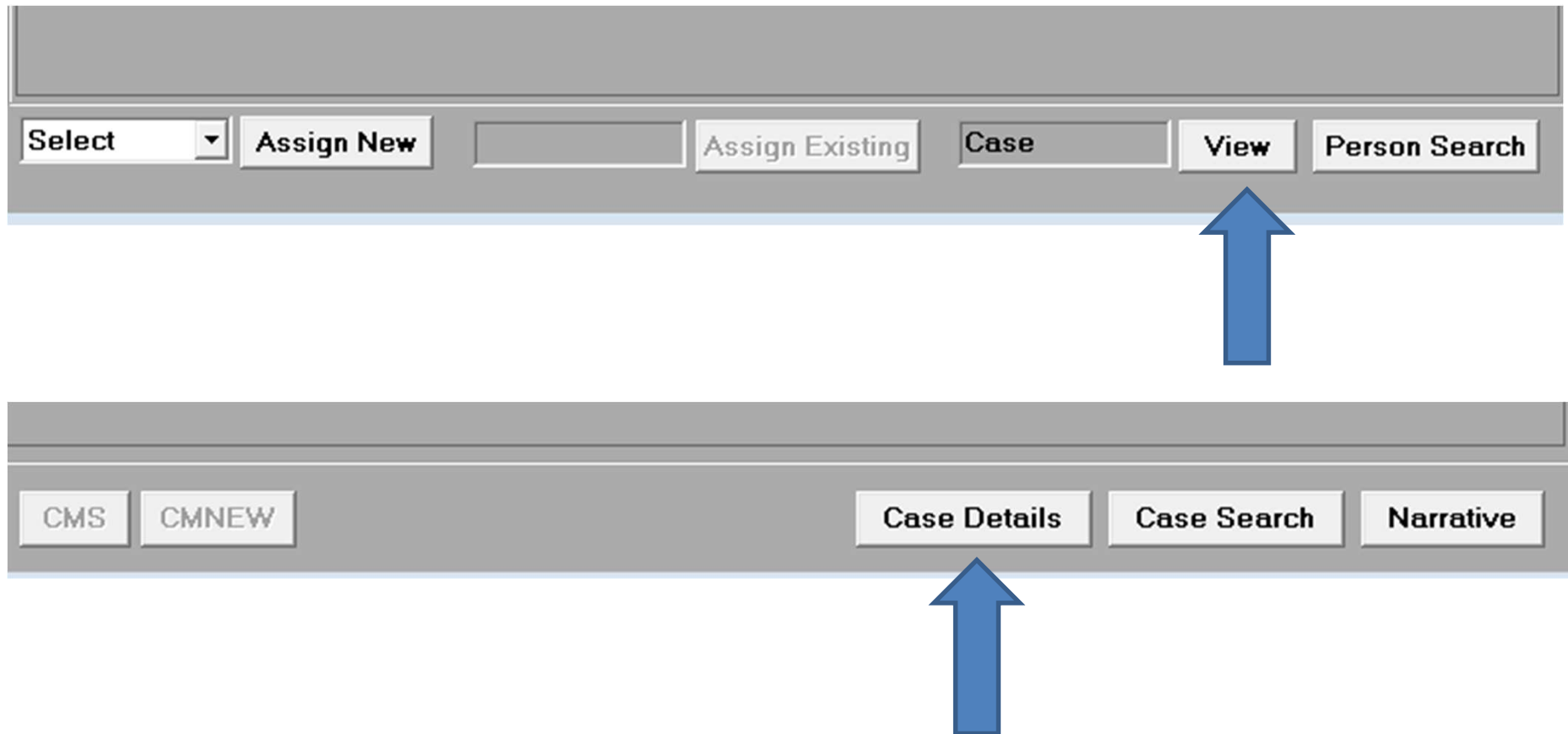
