- AAA types: A & B

- Used for requests for medical grade PPE, provider or consumer exposure to COVID-19, requests for case staffing, information about COVID-19 resources, and provider terminations as a result of COVID-19 related violations.

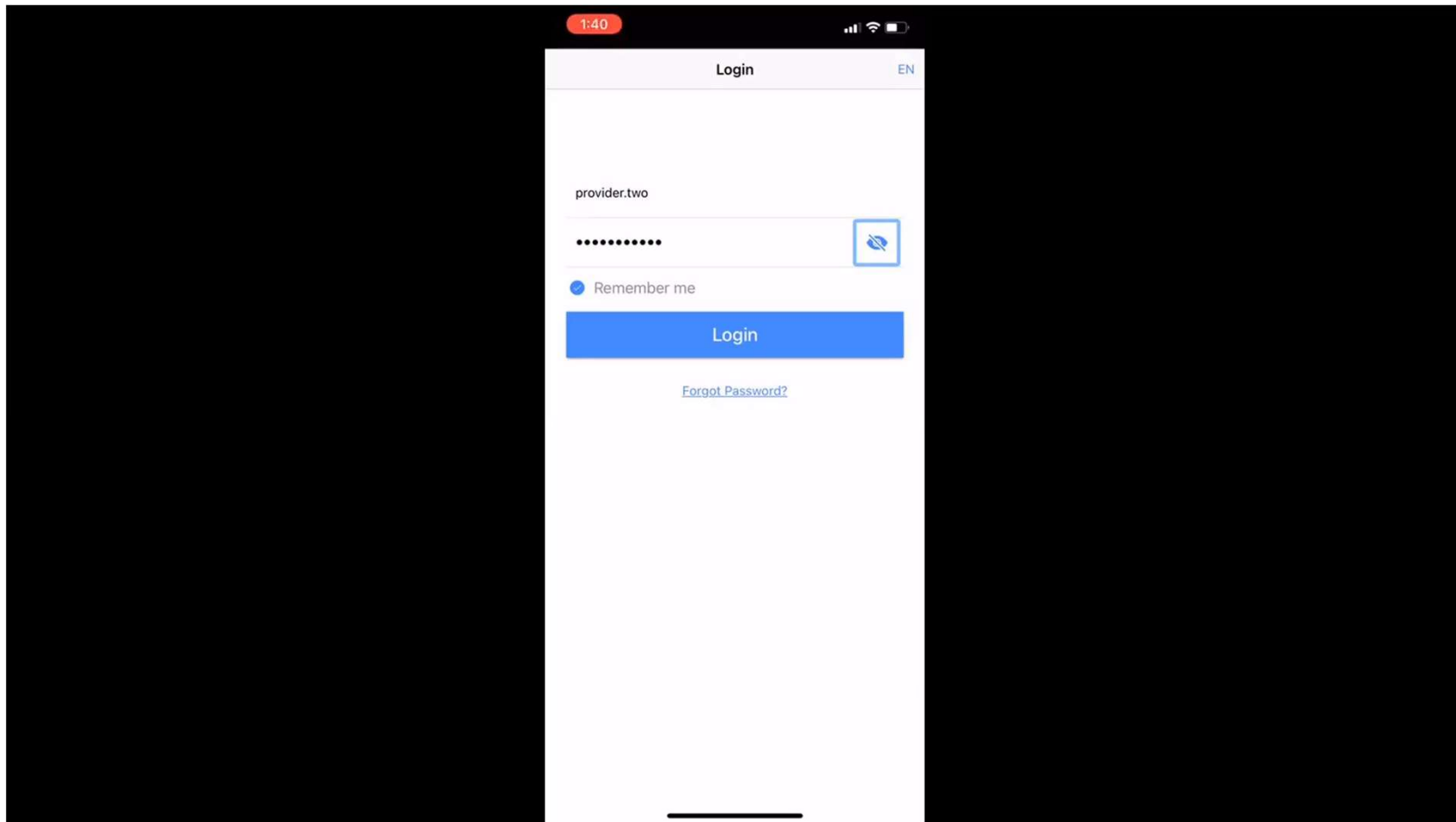

 - Email address

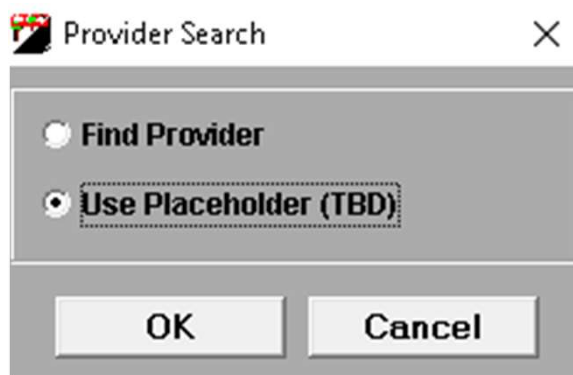

OPI In-home care agencies

- IHCAs are locally contracted
- Historically, IHCAs would receive a Medicaid provider number for service planning purposes
- OPI doesn't require that IHCAs have a comprehensive license
- IHCAs may choose to contract with OPI and not with Medicaid

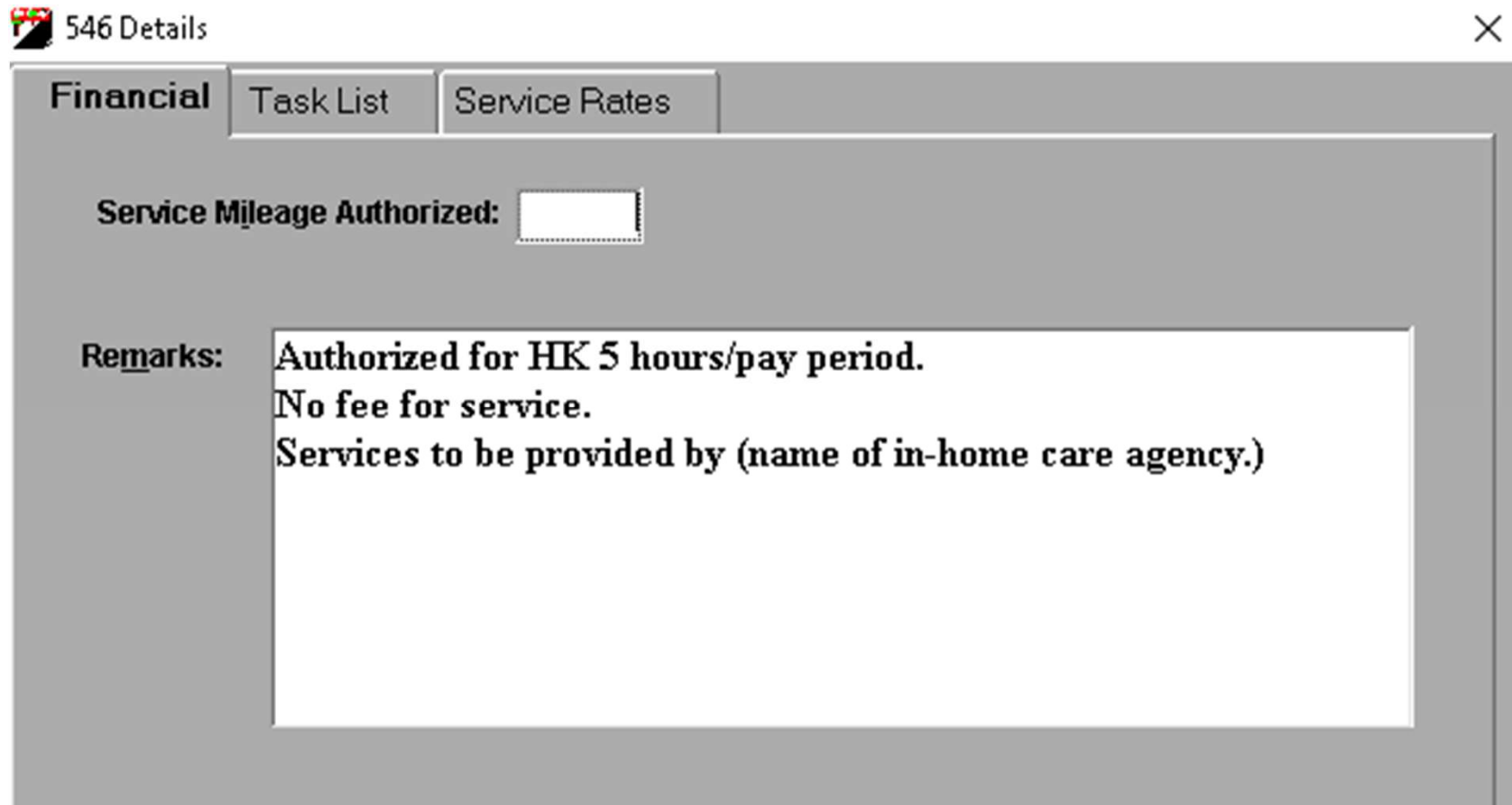

OPI and Medication Management

411-015-0007 (7) Instrumental Activities of Daily Living

"Medication Management" means the ability to order, organize and administer prescribed medications. Administering prescribed medications includes pills, drops, ointments, creams, injections, inhalers and suppositories unrelated to bowel care. Administering as a paid service means set-up, reminding, cueing, checking for effect and monitoring for choking while taking medications. Oxygen management is included in medication management. Oxygen management means assisting with the administration of oxygen, monitoring the equipment and assuring adequate oxygen supply.

411-032-0010 Authorized Services and Allowable Costs

Home care supportive services limited to the following:

- (i) Home care;
- (ii) Chore;
- (iii) Assistive technology device;
- (iv) Personal care;
- (v) Adult day services;
- (vi) Registered nurse services; and
- (vii) Home delivered meals.

Registered Nurse Services

411-032-0000 (47) Definitions

"Registered Nurse Services" mean services provided by a registered nurse on a short-term or intermittent basis that include but are not limited to:

- (a) Interviewing the individual and, when appropriate, other relevant parties;
- (b) Assessing the individual's ability to perform tasks;
- (c) Preparing a service plan that includes treatment needed by the individual;
- (d) Monitoring medication; and
- (e) Training and educating providers around the provisions of the service plan.
