OR PTC DCI Updates

- Auto-approval process is now running 5 times a day. This should reduce pending entries list throughout the day.
- Update on Fob Supply/Distribution:
 - Fobs are on backorder due to supply chain issues. They are currently mailing 4-6 weeks out from the original request date.
 - Historical time entries are the best backup option. Providers should track the dates/times they work if they are awaiting a fob for their consumer and can enter their time as historical entries in the web portal.

APD-AR-21-066 Case Management, Adult Protective Services, Central Office, and Licensing resumption of in-person activities

- AAA types: A & B
- Beginning December 1, 2021 – case management in-person activities may resume.
- Full in-person activities will resume no later than January 3, 2022.
- Staff *may not* ask consumers if they have had the COVID-19 vaccine.
- Staff *may* ask COVID-19 symptom screening questions prior to in-person visits.

APD-AR-21-066 continued

- Masks and other appropriate PPE should continue to be used when performing in-person activities.
- If a consumer asks about staff vaccination status – see transmittal for wording that you can use.
- If a consumer refuses an in-person visit to complete an assessment, attempt to assure that masks and PPE will be used in addition to physical distancing. If they still refuse, staff with your supervisor or send a request to OPI.policy@dhsosha.state.or.us so a virtual visit can be approved. Please determine if your agency would prefer supervisor approval or central office approval.

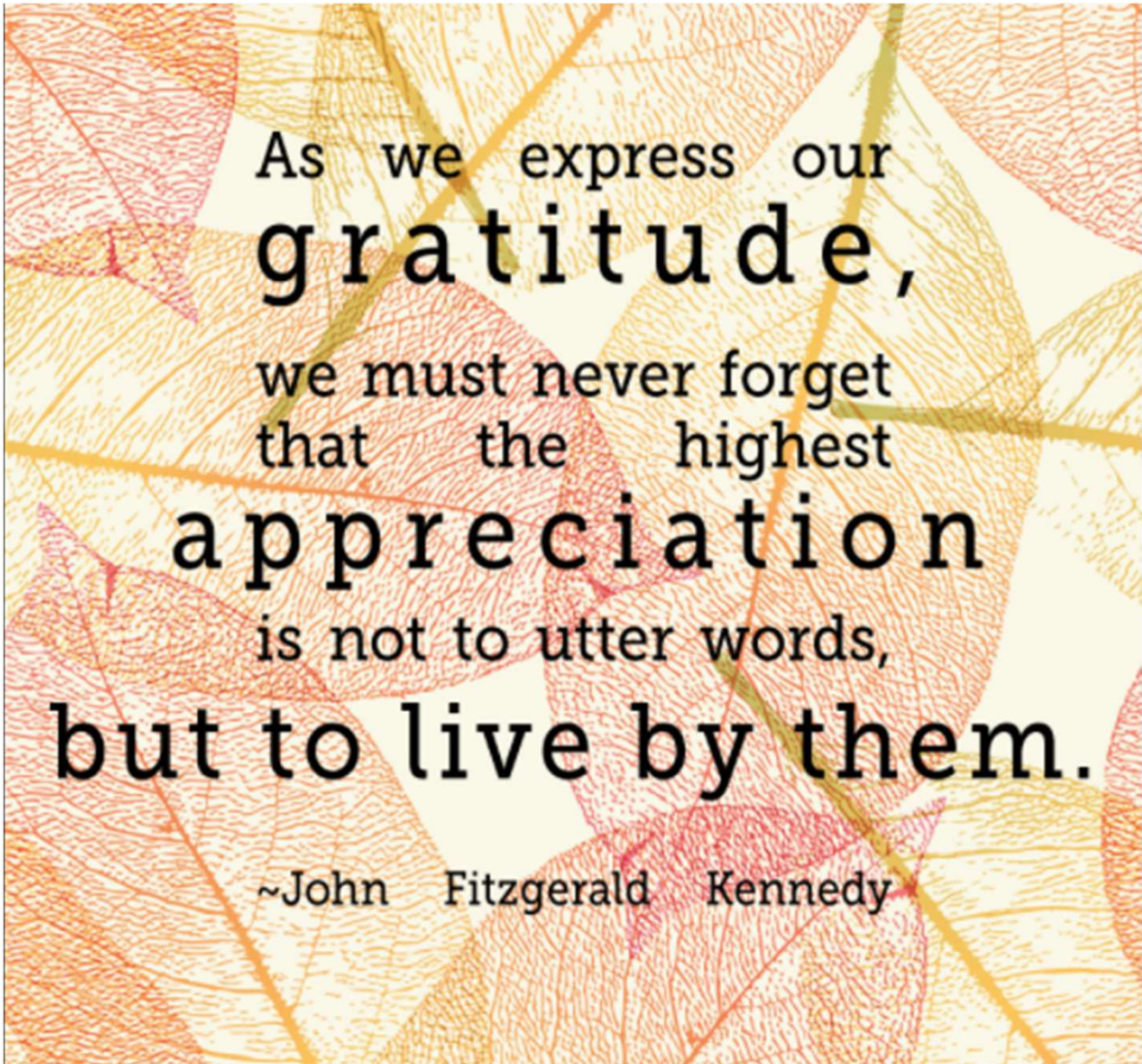

OPI Updates

- 1115 waiver has been approved by CMS!
- Currently open for 30-day public comment at the federal level
- Workgroups currently in process to discuss business operations and policy
- Currently being called, OPIM (Oregon Project Independence – Medicaid)

OPI Updates

- Waitlist workgroup is on hold – continue using the existing tool to add/update consumers on the waitlist.
- [Required OPI forms list](#) is being updated to include the use of the 3010 and removing the OPI waitlist tool at redetermination.
- OPI OARs will be updated to coincide with OPIM roll-out.
- OPI monitoring is underway – final monitoring review is due by January 31, 2022.
