Worker Load Codes

What is it?

A two or three character code

Why is it important?

Without a load code, case managers cannot approve service plans.

Code	Error Message
00141	NO WORKER ID PASSED

Worker Load Codes

If...

- This is your first time approving a service plan and you receive this error, follow the steps on the next slides to request a load code.

If...

- You have previously been able to approve service plans and you suddenly receive this error, submit a service desk ticket to: OIS.SERVICEDESK@odhsoha.oregon.gov

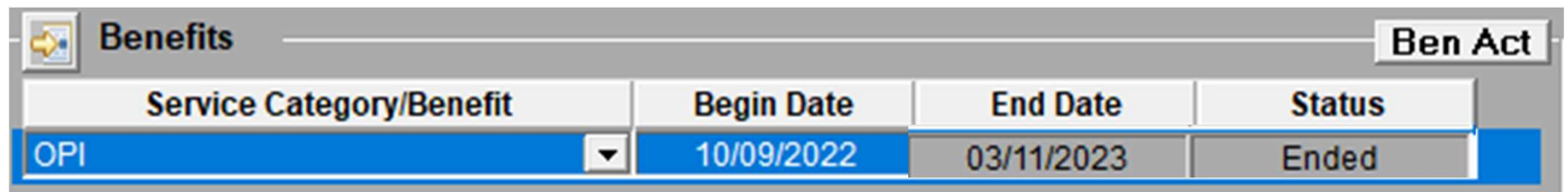

Death Closures

- End the benefit segment, hours segment and service segment in OA with the date of death.

- Closure notice does not need to be sent to the deceased.
- Notice **does** need to be sent to paid providers to notify of closure.
- OPI does not utilize the Estate Administration Unit (EAU).

Oregon ACCESS Release: April 21, 2023

Oregon ACCESS will not be available between 5:00pm on Friday, April 21 through 6:00am on Sunday, April 23.

Important steps:

- Check-in all cases by 5:00pm on Friday, April 21!
- Log out of Oregon ACCESS.

End of the Public Health Emergency

- Medicare Savings Program (MSP) will be included in the eligibility reviews that began on April 1.

End of the Public Health Emergency

- Individuals may lose benefits if they do not respond to requests for more information.
- Please ensure individuals know how to update their contact information so they don't miss important communication from ODHS.

Q: Can we have a Family Caregiver Support Program (FCSP) presentation?

Q: When will we get ONE read only rights?

A: Working on this for type A offices. It was added to the last contract amendment, access agreements are in process.

Q: APD offices closing OPI without notifying OPI case managers.

A: Communication with APD is ongoing at central office and the local level.

Q: Are hospitals providing medical eligibility assistance for individuals?

A: They should not be doing that unless the person is incapacitated and unable to make decisions or act on their own behalf.

Q: Is OSIPM – Pickle a disqualifier for OPI?

A: Yes, these individuals receive OHP plus and cannot have OPI.
