This letter is in response to your email request on April 17, 2023, for version clarification for Map 2, Vicinity and Access Map, in the Grassy Mountain Mine Consolidated Permit Application (CPA). DOGAMI had two versions of Map 2 – one called GMM_Figure_2_BLM_Land_Access_Map.pdf, and the other was included in the file called GMM CPA Maps 1-6.pdf.

This letter accompanies the submittal of current versions of the files listed below.

- Vicinity Access Roads Shapefile 20230418.zip (new)

The emergency access road was the same between the two figures. However, the “BLM” version of the map had an older version of the mine access road. The map update includes the vicinity access roads shapefiles with two new data columns titled “AccessRoad” and “ST_County”. Any roads that are part of the access road from Highway 20 to the mine site are designated as “Mine Access Road” under the “AccessRoad” column. The “ST_County” designates whether a section of road is under federal or county control.
