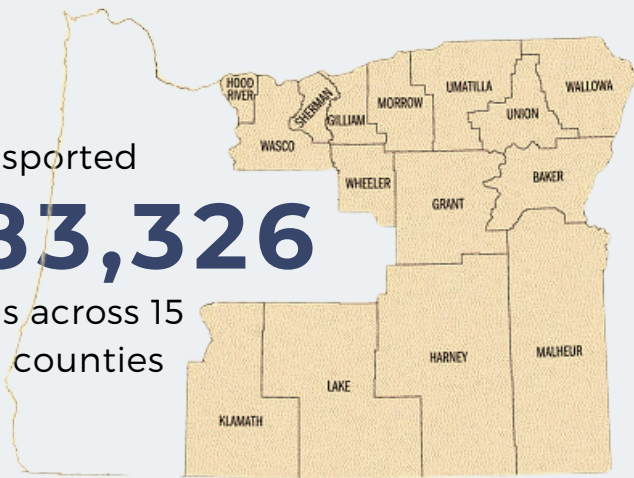
IMPROVING ACCESS TO INFORMATION

BUILDING STRONGER COMMUNITIES THROUGH COLLABORATION

The State Library partnered with Oregon Humanities to train 40 library staff to lead reflective conversations about democracy, inclusion, and civic engagement.



29 libraries across the state partnered to provide Answerland, a 24/7 statewide service coordinated by the State Library that connects Oregonians to librarians.
