

2025 LPGT and LOM Video Series

ODE leadership made the decision to not co-develop two additional years of LPGTs with grantees following the 2025 application process. Instead, grantees will continue to use existing targets set in 2023 for the 2023-28 school years. This decision does not release grantees from accountability tied to existing targets; the decision only reflects a move to not add two additional years of targets at this time. Grantees are still accountable to the targets set through 2027-28.

The Oregon Department of Education's Office of Education Innovation and Improvement (EII) released a series of informational videos on Longitudinal Performance Growth Targets (LPGTs) and Local Optional Metrics (LOMs) in early 2025. The purpose of the video series is to help districts navigate the process and set realistic, ambitious goals.

Videos were pre-recorded. Two videos were posted each month beginning in February and running through April, for a total of seven videos with another video coming later. Below is the outline of the planned video series. Periodic updates will include links to videos as they are posted.
