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Background

In July of 2015, [Senate Bill 612](#) was passed by the Oregon Legislature requiring the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to 1) designate a Dyslexia Specialist to provide school districts with support and [resources](#) to assist students with dyslexia and their families and 2) develop and communicate annually a list of training opportunities related to dyslexia. Additionally, the bill required each school district to ensure that at least one Kindergarten-5th grade teacher in each K-5 school receives training from this approved list and inclusive of content in all of the following focus areas:

- ✓ Understanding and Recognizing Dyslexia (URD)
- ✓ Using evidence-based practices to systematically and explicitly teach the foundational skills in reading (FSR)
- ✓ Intensifying instruction to meet the needs of students with severe reading difficulties, including dyslexia.

This requirement, outlined by OAR [581-022-2440 \(Teacher Training Related to Dyslexia\)](#) went into effect in 2018, at which time the Department began annually publishing a *List of Approved Dyslexia-Related Training Opportunities* based on criteria included in [OAR 581-002-1805](#) and in alignment with the [International Dyslexia Association's Knowledge and Practice Standards for Teachers of Reading](#).
