Project Name: Bingocize Project

Funded Entity: Southern Oregon University

Project Description: Bingocize Oregon will support and promote health and social interactions across the lifespan among Oregon certified skilled nursing residents within 22 participating Oregon Certified Skilled Nursing (SNF) Residents through Bingocize. This was approved as an extension project of other CMS approved Bingocize Projects in the US. Primary objectives are to improve and maintain participating residents' mobility, social connects and support their independence. This project also aims to educate all participants to help reduce falls, improve nutrition and learn about other positive impact health related behaviors while engaging in light exercise while playing Bingo.

Project Dates: April 17, 2025 – April 30, 2028

Total Funding: \$329,206.00

Outcomes: This project is ongoing. Interim status reports continue to report positive results and positive feedback from participants. Final project results will be available in CY 2028

Project Name: Sparking Joy Art Kits

Funded Entity: SilverKite Community Arts Consulting, LLC

Project Description: Sparking Art Joy Art Kits provides pre-boxed art kits to participating residents in 29 Oregon Certified Nursing Facilities. The project includes up to 14 art projects per participant - filled with supplies necessary to follow along and participate in art projects

and online art programs. Residents benefit from the creative and artistic engagement that relieves stress and improves their overall quality of life.

Project Dates: Nov. 1, 2025 – Oct. 31, 2026

Total Funding: \$121,147.23

Outcomes: This project is ongoing. Final outcomes will be available in late 2026 and posted or linked here.

Project Name: Oregon Furry Friends Project - "Joy for All" Robotic Pets

Funded Entity: Ageless Innovation, LLC

Project Description: This project is an extension of other CMS approved projects in the United States. This project will use the robotic pets to improve the quality of life for nursing home residents who are in memory care, experiencing social isolation or suffering from depression.

Project Dates: Dec. 1, 2025 – Nov. 30, 2026

Total Funding: \$174,635.00
