Personal Hygiene	Hands-on Cueing Stand-by
Dressing	Hands-on Cueing Stand-by
Grooming	Hands-on Cueing Stand-by
Self-preservation	Cueing Hands-on Monitoring Reassurance Redirection Support
Decision making	Cueing Hands-on Monitoring Redirection Support
Ability to make self-understood	Cueing Hands-on Monitoring Reassurance Redirection Support
Challenging behaviors	Cueing Hands-on Monitoring Redirection Reassurance
