- 400% of Federal Poverty Level (FPL) for Family of One

Effective January 1, 2023	\$4,860.00
Effective January 1, 2024	\$5,020.00
Effective January 1, 2025	\$5,217.00
Effective January 1, 2026	\$5,320.00

OPI-M Resource Standard for an Individual

Year	Basic Daily Nursing Facility Rate	Resource Limit (Rounded)
July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025	\$518.22	\$94,523.00
July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026	\$546.36	\$99,656.00

- The resource limit is calculated using the basic statutory daily nursing facility rate as described in [OAR 411-070-0075\(1\)](#) multiplied by 30.4

(average days per month) multiplied by six (6) months. See the [Long-Term Care Rates](#) schedule to find the current basic daily nursing facility rate.

Note: At initial eligibility, the resources of the spouse (see [OAR 461-001- 0000](#)) are considered, and the provisions of [OAR 461-160- 0580\(2\)\(f\)\(A\)](#) apply. Staff determining OPI-M eligibility will utilize the [OPI-M Resource Assessment Calculator](#) to accurately determine resources allowances.
