Forms Update – Oregon Police Traffic Crash Report and Oregon Police Traffic Crash Report Addition	Effective January 2026
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DMV recently updated both Forms [735-46A](#) (“Oregon Police Traffic Crash Report”) and [735-46B](#) (“Oregon Police Traffic Crash Report Addition”). January 2026 is the current version for both forms (as denoted by “(1-26)” at the bottom left corner of page 1).

All fillable PDF versions of DMV’s police crash forms are available at ODOT’s [Police Traffic Enforcement](#) webpage, under the “Police Traffic Crash Forms” accordion. The forms include Form 735-47 (“Police Truck/Bus/Hazmat Crash Supplemental” — current version is 1-24) and Form 735-6110 (“Request for DMV Forms to be Mailed”). Use Form 735-6110 to order paper DMV forms.

If your agency uses an electronic reporting software to complete crash reports — and your agency intends to update that software to reflect the current form versions — you may reach out to DMVDriverControl@odot.oregon.gov with any questions. DMV can assist with identifying changes to the forms since your last update. We can also help coordinate with the ODOT Transportation Safety Office (TSO) to determine whether any grant funding may be available for your software update.

Revised Instruction Manual for Police Crash Forms	Effective April 2026
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DMV also recently published a revised Instruction Manual in April (Form [735-6596](#)). The revisions to the manual are mostly implementing plain language. Additions or new information are limited to altered or new fields on the crash report forms (e.g., the new “Truck Underride” checkbox or the “Harmful Events” section).

The Instruction Manual is **only** available as a PDF online at the Police Traffic Enforcement webpage referenced above.
