Motor home, motorcycle, and moped can ONLY get a yellow background plate.

PLATE SURCHARGES:

Crater Lake: \$30 surcharge at initial issuance.

Salmon, Wine Country: \$30 surcharge at initial issuance and every renewal. \$60 Salmon surcharge at four-year initial issuance.

Golf Oregon, Gray Whale, OSU Beavers, Oregon Zoo, Pollinator Paradise, Smokey Bear, Trail Blazers, UO Ducks, Watch for Wildlife: \$40 surcharge at initial issuance and every renewal.

Cultural: \$50 surcharge at initial issuance and every renewal.

Amateur radio call letter registration plates can only be issued for motor vehicles owned by residents of Oregon who hold valid, unrevoked, and unexpired radio station licenses issued by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The Oregon license plate is designed for six characters, so only call signs with a maximum of six characters will fit on the Oregon amateur radio operator plates.

I certify:

- I am eligible for the plate I have requested above.
- I will notify DMV if my FCC amateur radio license is canceled, expired, revoked, or terminated, or if my FCC call sign changes.

Under Oregon law, it is a crime to knowingly make any false statement on an application for title or registration (ORS 803.070, 803.075, 803.375 and 803.385). These offenses are Class A misdemeanors and are punishable by a jail sentence of up to one year, a fine of up to \$6,250, or both.
