Check Box	What you are required to have:
☐	Must reside in the United States of America.
☐	A copy of a valid driver's license, passport or other valid government issued identification. (<i>Must be at least 18 years of age</i>)
☐	Current RID (Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf) Certification (National Interpreter Certification [NIC] or Certified Deaf Interpreter Certification [CDI])
☐	Include proof of passing a Sign Language proficiency exam, such as the American Sign Language Proficiency Interview or SLPI:ASL. For more information see Oregon Qualification and Certification for Sign Language Interpreters
☐	Proof of high school diploma (or GED equivalent) or higher.
☐	Proof of not being on the Medicaid exclusion list http://exclusions.oig.hhs.gov/
☐	Note: By first renewal, qualified Sign Language interpreters must complete a 60-hour OHA approved health care interpreter training program , along with other 24 hours of CEUs renewing requirements .
