

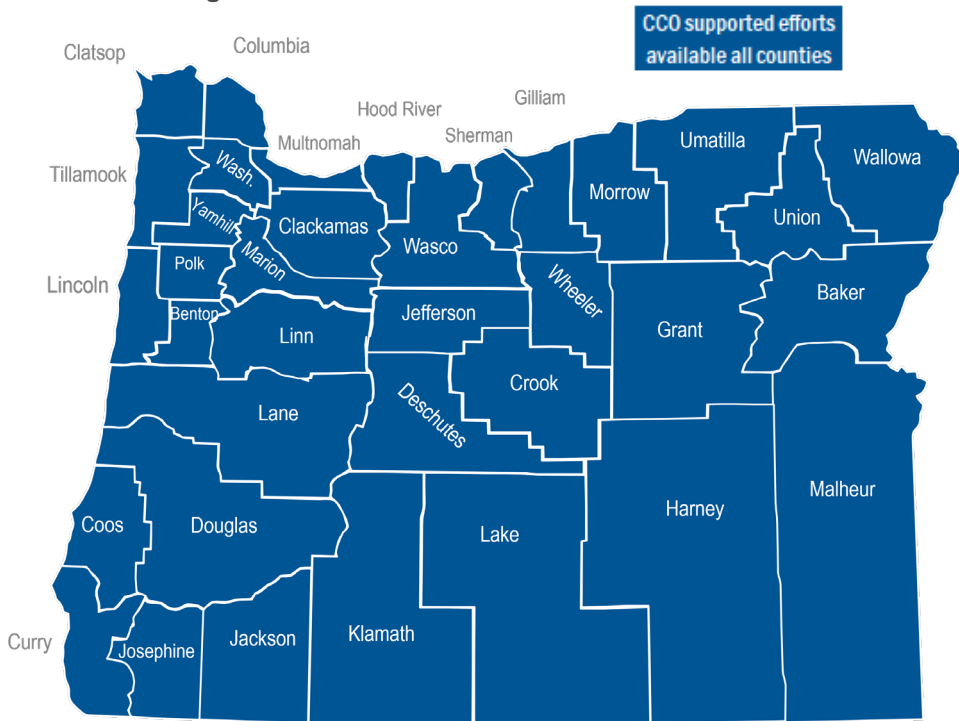
Oregon CIE Maps: Status of supported efforts March 2026

All coordinated care organizations (CCOs), and some health systems and health plans, have bought community information exchange (CIE) technology, making it available in all Oregon counties. Tribes, community-based organizations, clinics, local public health authorities, health-related social needs providers and others also use CIE, with many able to join for free.

There are two main CIE efforts currently in Oregon — Connect Oregon/Unite Us and Findhelp (known locally in southern Klamath county as Healthy Klamath Connect).

These maps show where CIE is supported by CCOs; they do not reflect level of CIE adoption by organizations. OHA is not currently participating in CIE and anticipates contracting with both vendors in the coming year.
