

Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan (OPSRP) Award of Disability Benefits

This form is to be completed upon the award of any current or future OPSRP disability benefit to an alternate payee (AP) or former registered domestic partner (RDP) in connection with an annulment, divorce, separation, dissolution of registered domestic partnerships or property settlement.

Section B: Award type (check one)

Section C: Award information

Disability benefits for a member are calculated at 45% of the member's last full month of salary before disability begins.

The award to the AP/former RDP will be applied to any unpaid retroactive disability payments accrued after this date.

- Retires under early retirement provisions, **or**
- Reaches normal retirement age.

The AP will not receive a portion of the member's disability payment if the AP is retired under a Separate Benefit election when the disability benefit begins.

The AP's portion of the disability benefit will end and revert to the member if the AP retires under a Separate Benefit election while the member is receiving disability benefits.
