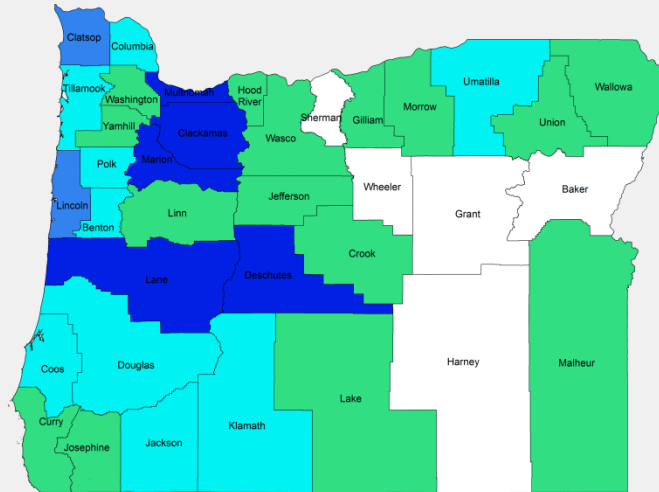

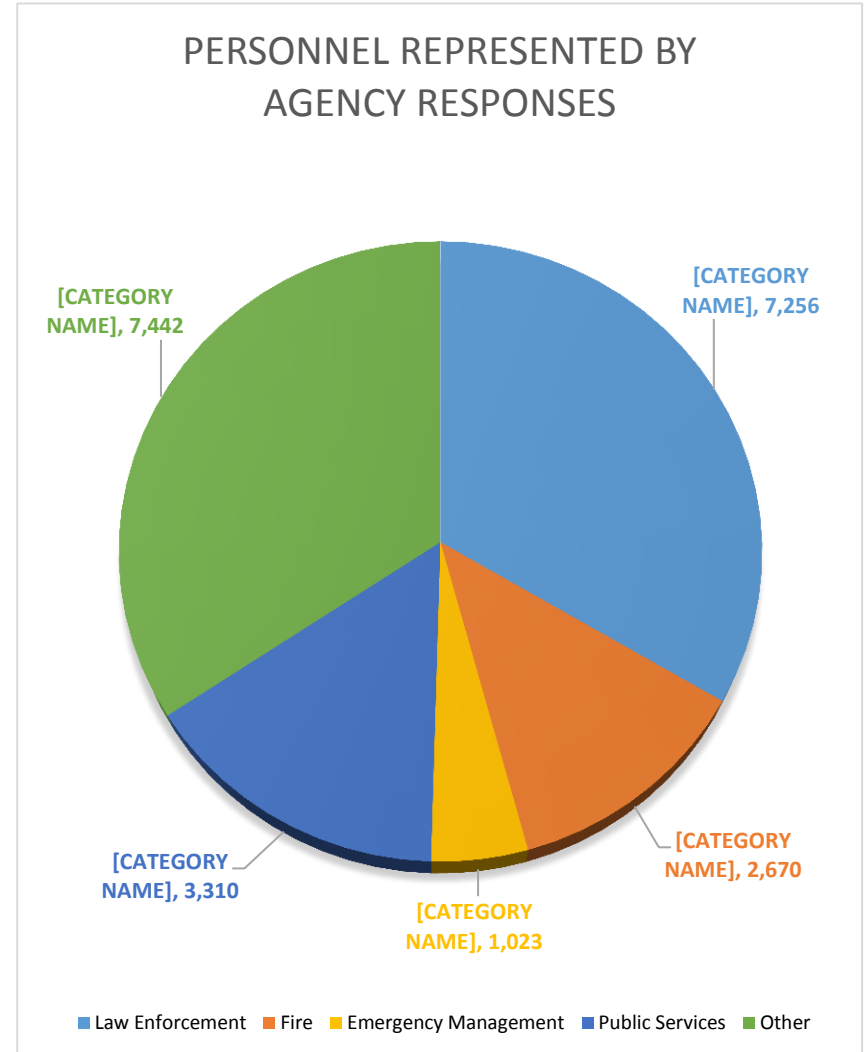
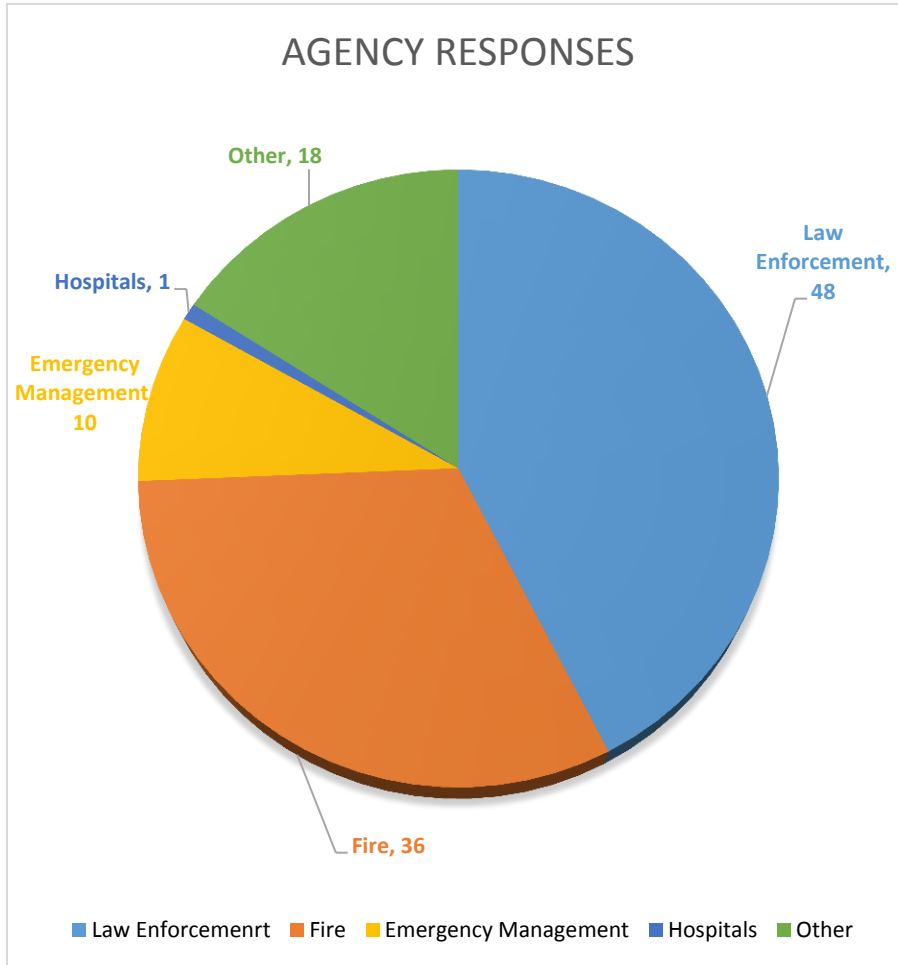


Number of Surveys by County

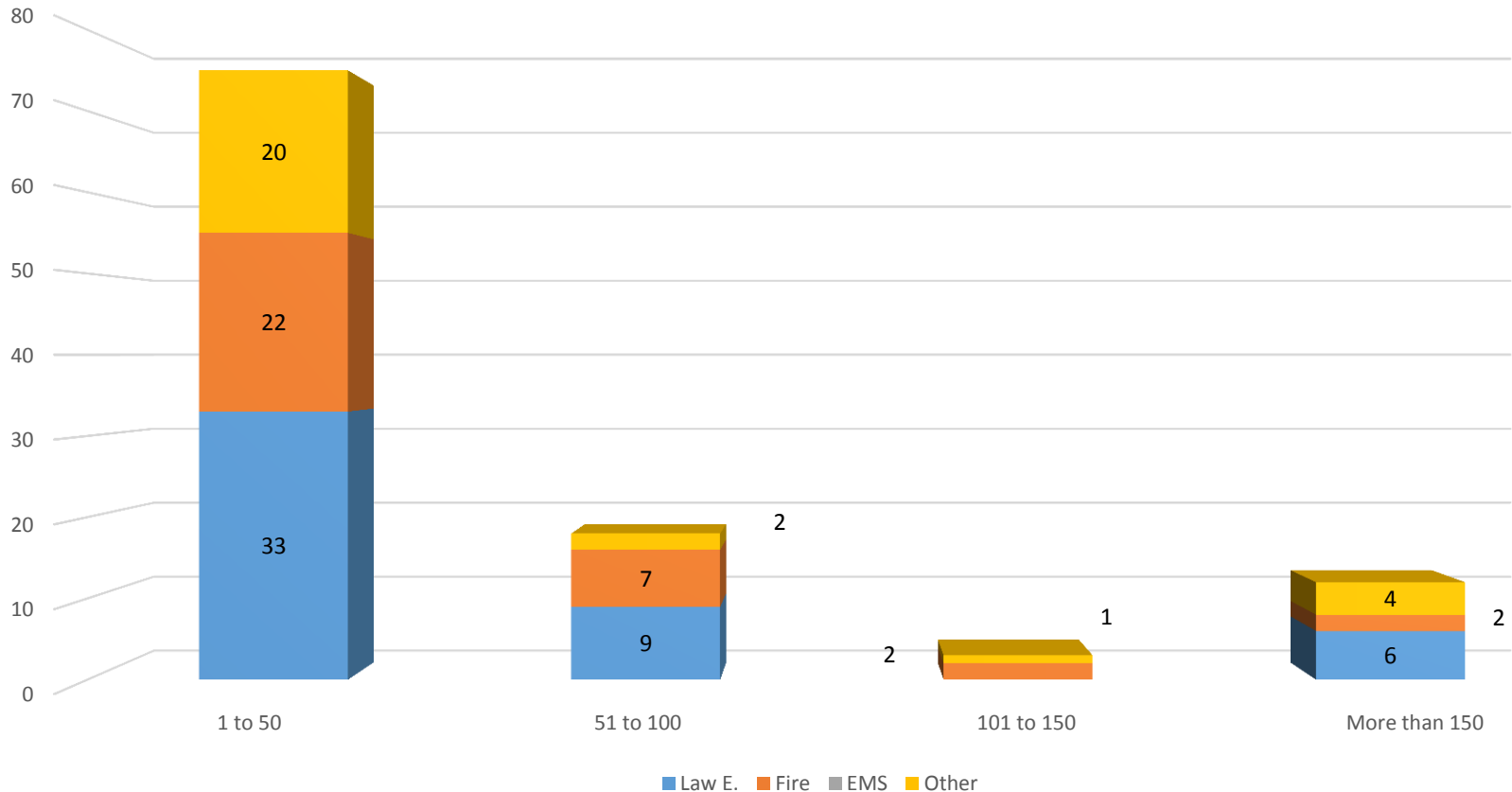

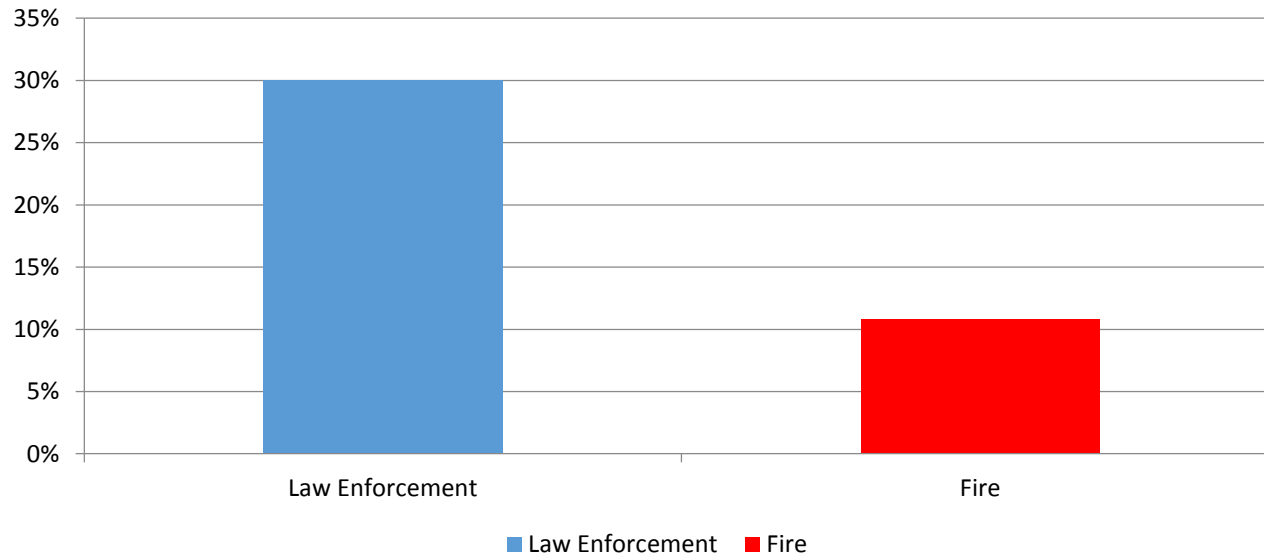

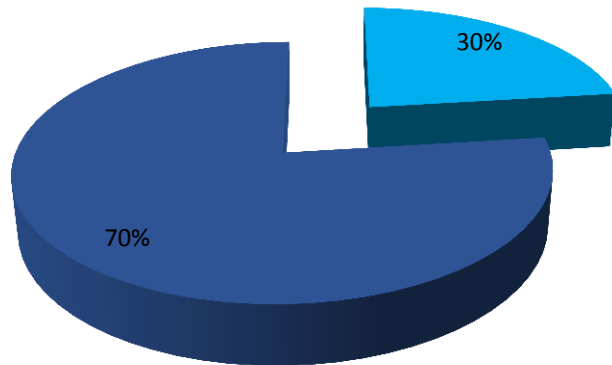

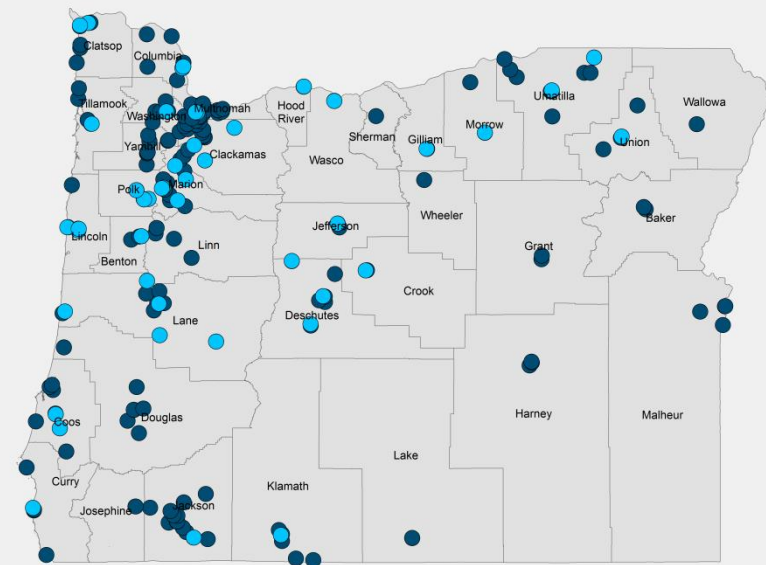


First Responder Sample Size: Law Enforcement

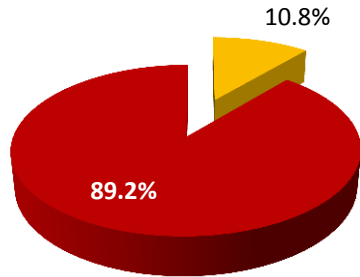

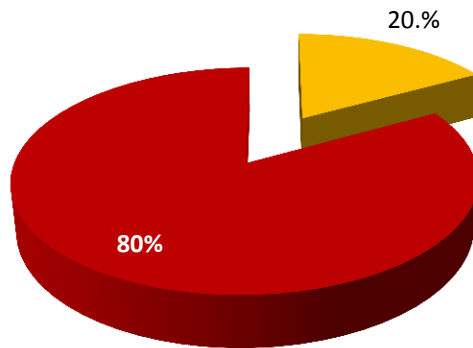
First Responder Sample Size: Fire Departments

% of Responses by Discipline

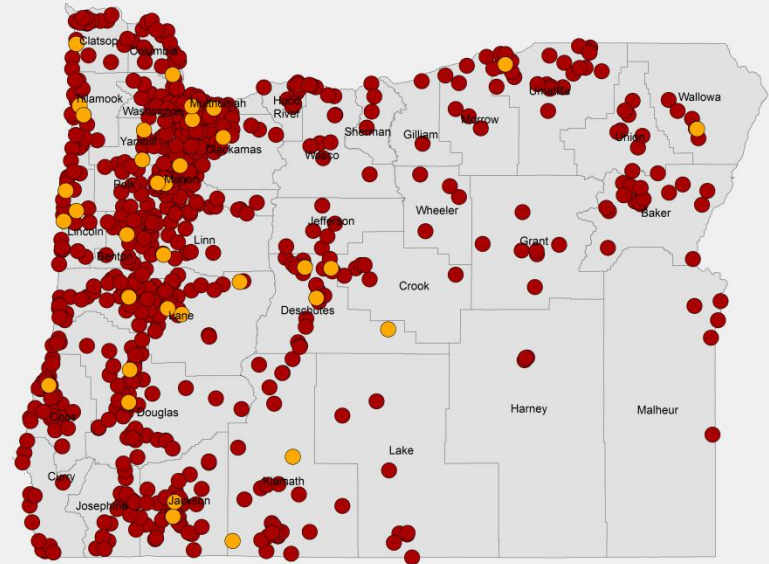

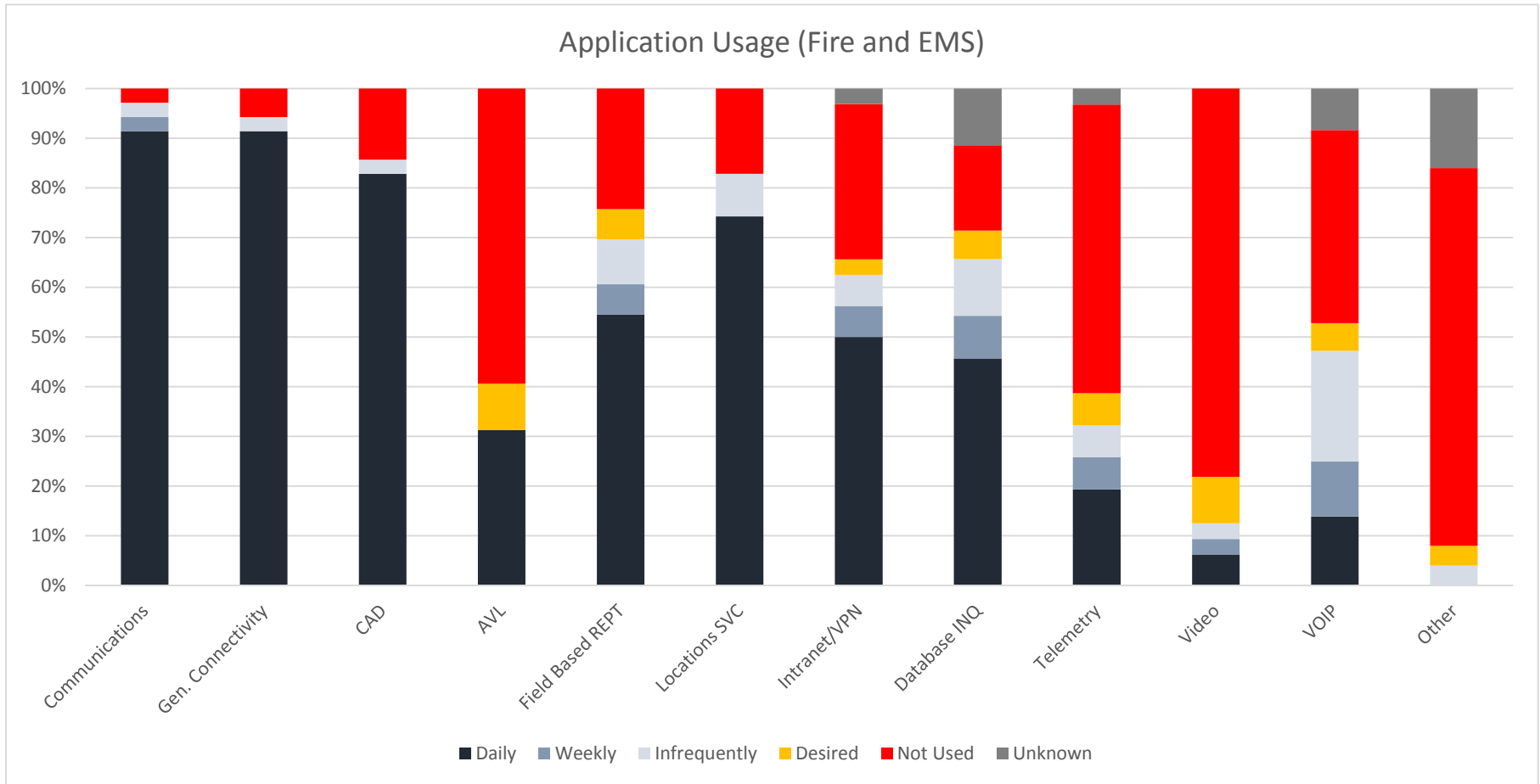

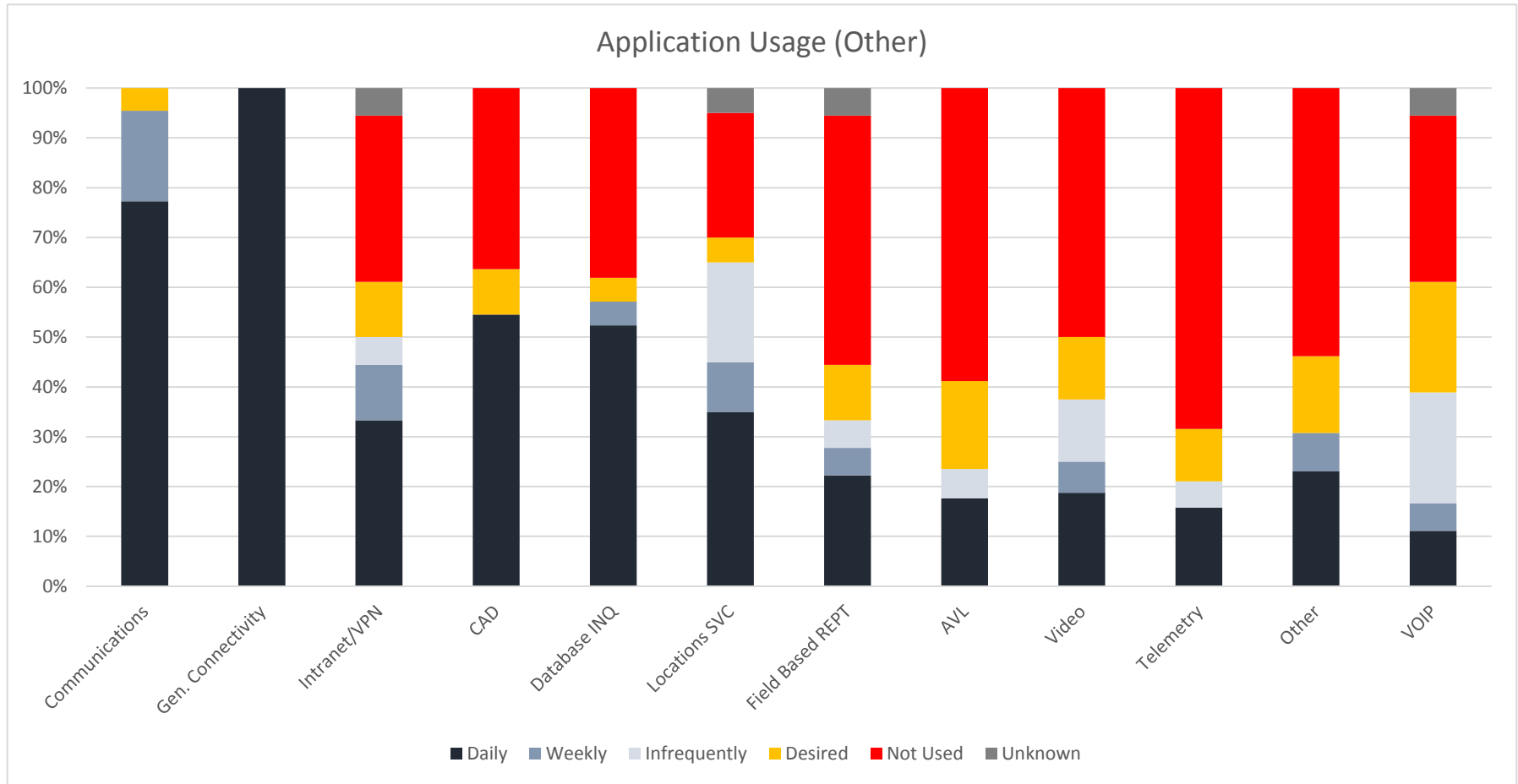

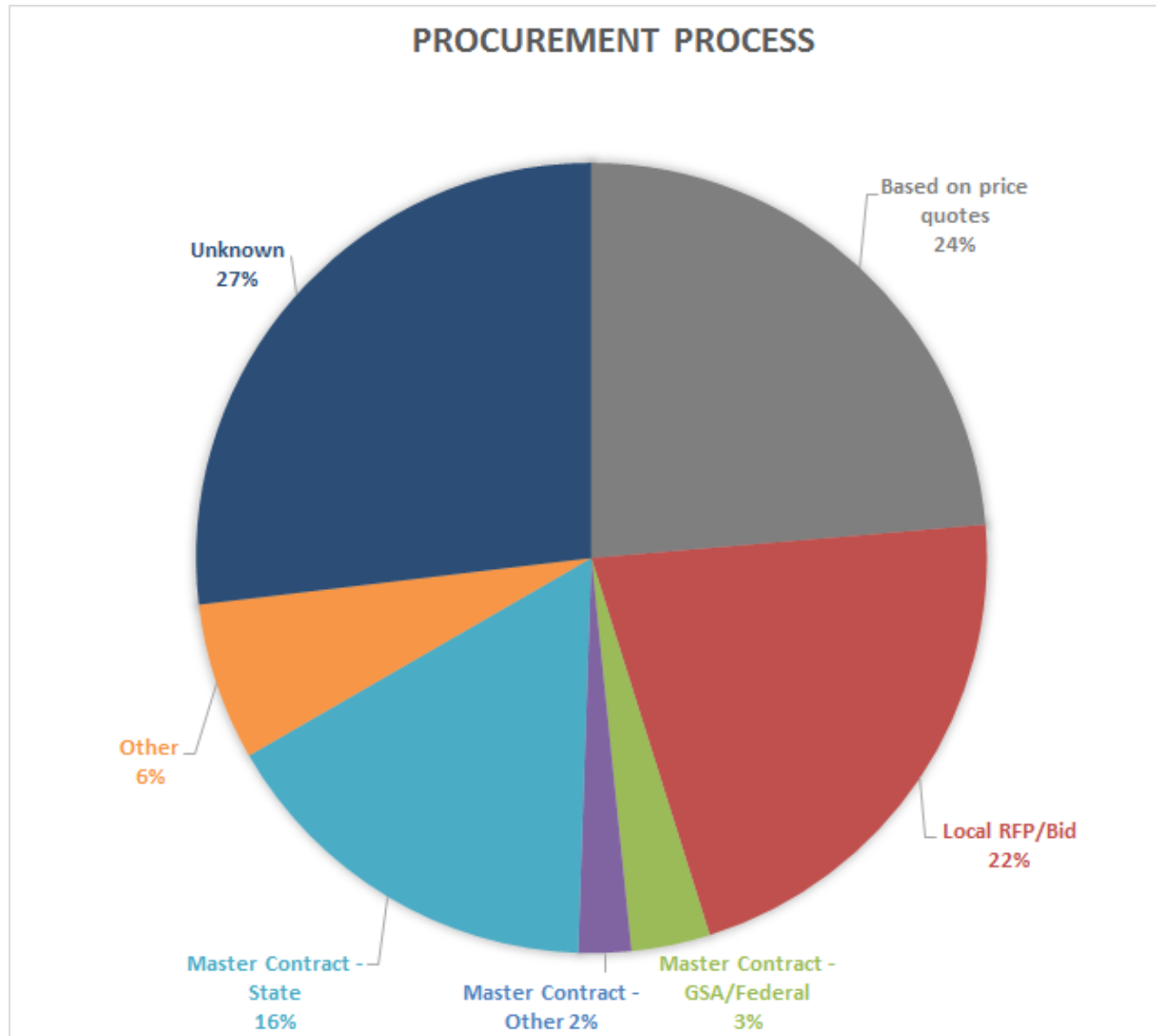
Application Usage – Fire & EMS

Average Monthly Fees

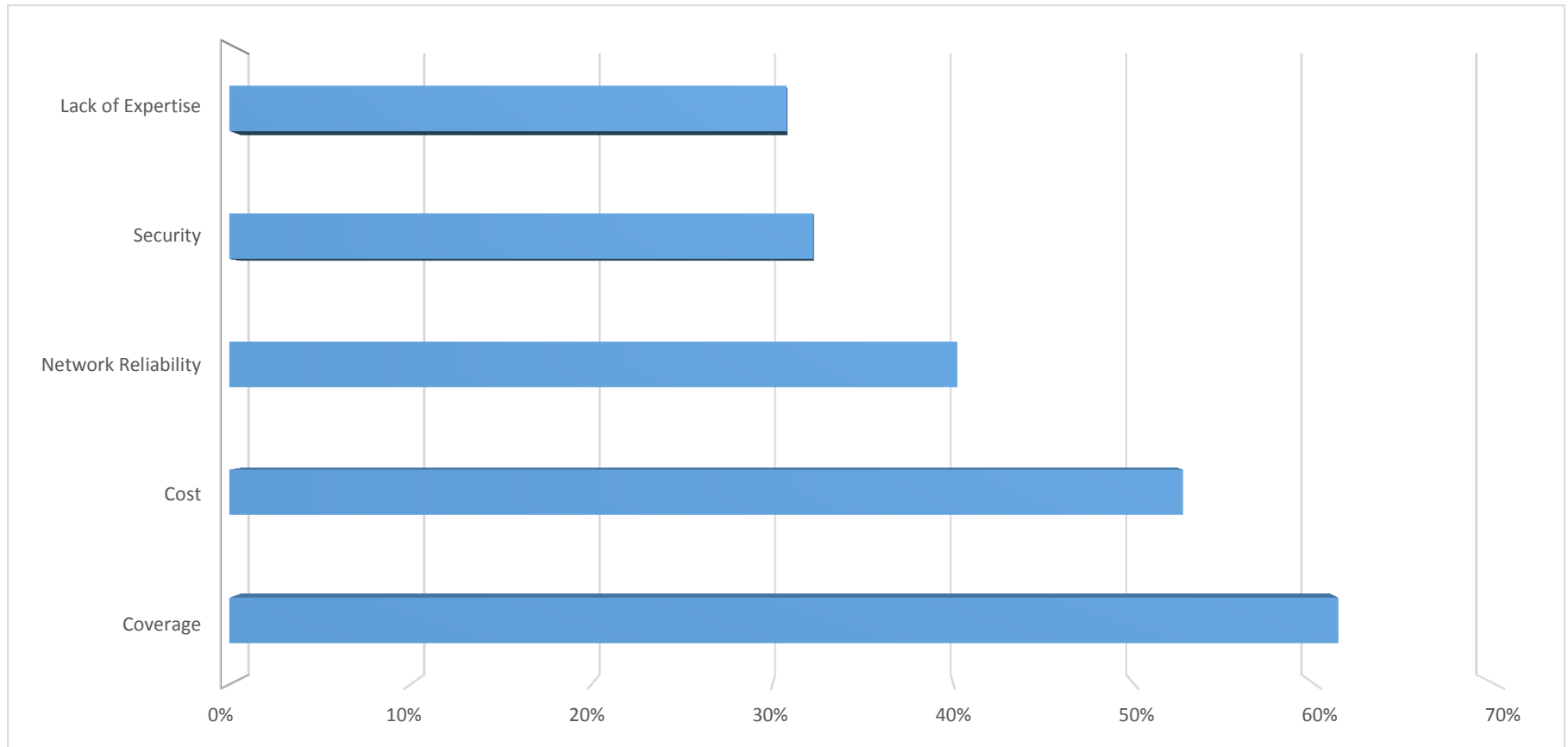


Average Monthly Usage



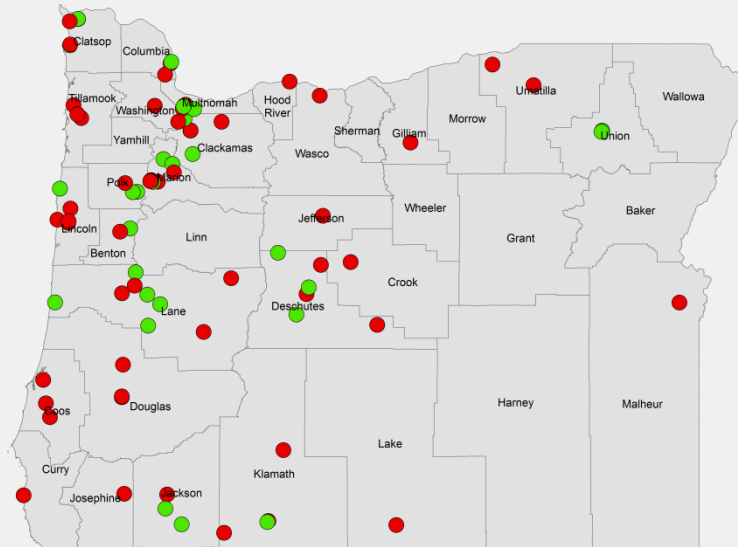

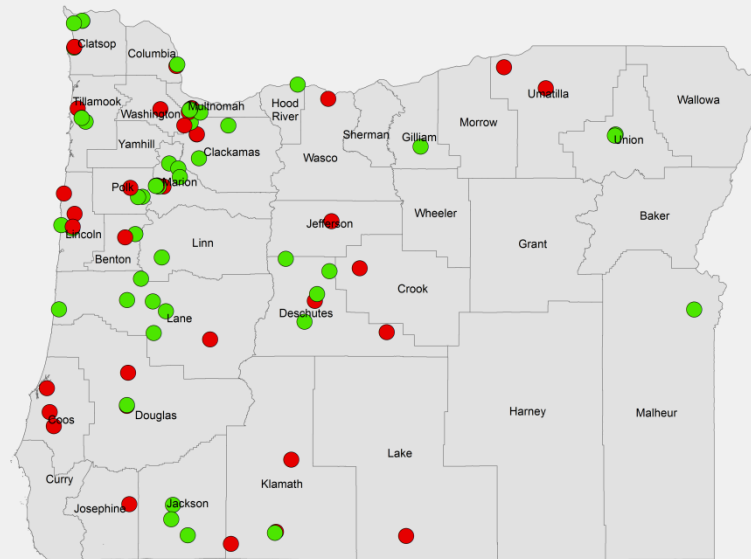

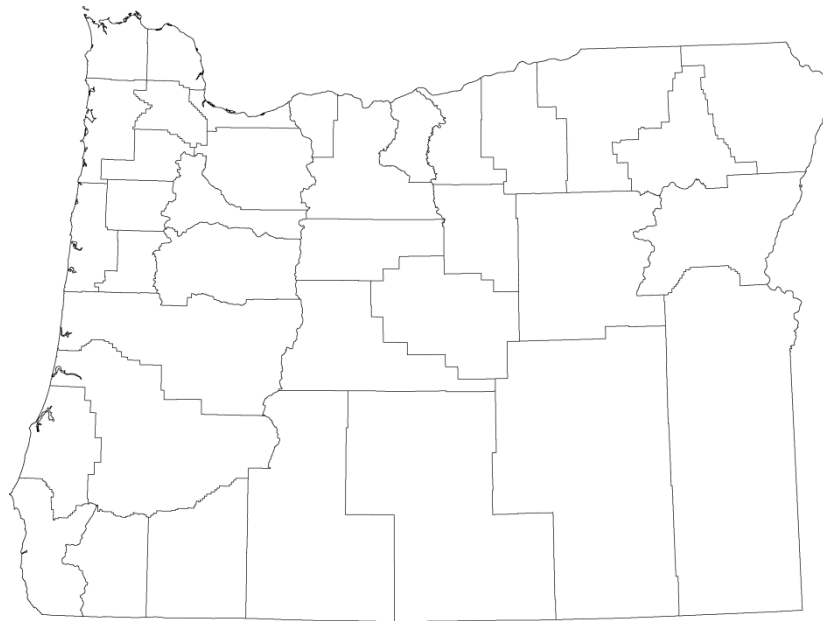
