DEFAULT ORDER OF
LICENSE REVOCATION AND
REVOCATION OF RIGHT TO
APPLY FOR LICENSE

On June 17, 2009, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Michael Cory Krager (Krager) in which the Commission charged him with conviction of a crime listed in ORS 342.143(3). The Notice was sent via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7008 1140 0002 8580 9348 to the address on file with the Commission. The U.S. Postal Service delivered two notices to Krager, the first on June 26, 2009, and the second on July 6, 2009, in an attempt to deliver this certified mail, before returning the certified mail receipt to the Commission on July 8, 2009. The first class mail was not returned to the Commission. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated June 17, 2009, and signed by Victoria Chamberlain, Executive Director, stated:

"You, Michael Cory Krager, are entitled to a hearing on the proposed action of the Commission. If you want a hearing, you must file a written request for a hearing with the Commission within 21 days of the date of this notice."

Mr. Krager did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Mr. Krager to be in default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, based on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Mr. Krager was licensed by the Commission from July 10, 2007 to January 10, 2009, at which time his license expired. There are no current applications for licensure on file.
2. On May 21, 2009, in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Multnomah County, Mr. Krager pled guilty and was convicted of Sexual Abuse 2.

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1 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

2 Mr. Krager's conviction of Sexual Abuse 2 is a conviction requiring revocation of his
3 license pursuant to ORS 342.175(2); ORS 342.143(3); and constitutes gross neglect of duty in
4 violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(1)(n) (ORS 163.452, Sexual Abuse in the
5 Second Degree).

6 **FINAL ORDER**

7 The Commission hereby revokes Michael Cory Krager's Initial Teaching License and
8 revokes his right to apply for a teaching license.
