DEFAULT ORDER OF
LICENSE REVOCATION

"You, Robert Richard Wilson, are entitled to a hearing on the proposed action of the Commission. If you want a hearing, you must file a written request for a hearing with the Commission within 21 days of the date of this notice. Attached to this notice is a copy of the procedures, right of representation and other rights of parties relating to the conduct of a hearing as required under ORS 183.413(2)."

FINDINGS OF FACT

2. Mr. Wilson was employed by Klamath County School District from 1987 until resignation effective January 24, 2003.

3. On January 10, 2003, David Davis, Superintendent, Klamath County School District, reported that Mr. Wilson chased a female student around his music room and spanked her on the buttocks. During the District investigation it was determined that Mr. Wilson engaged in similar behavior with another female student earlier in the school year.

4. On August 14, 2001, David Davis, Klamath County School District filed a report with the Commission alleging that Mr. Wilson violated Standards. On October 11, 2002, the Commission adopted a resolution stating there was insufficient cause to justify holding a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Mr. Wilson's inappropriate physical contact with students constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(4)(f). This conduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty. The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

ORDER

The Commission hereby revokes the Standard Personnel Service License and Standard Teaching License issued to Robert Richard Wilson.
