LANCE MICHAEL GILMORE) LICENSE REVOCATION

"You, Lance Michael Gilmore, are entitled to a hearing on the proposed action of the Commission. If you want a hearing, you must file a written request for a hearing with the Commission within 21 days of the date of this notice. Attached to this notice is a copy of the procedures, right of representation and other rights of parties relating to the conduct of a hearing as required under ORS 183.413(2)."

FINDINGS OF FACT

2. Mr. Gilmore was employed as a substitute teacher and coach for North Bend School District. He began employment on October 23, 2001, until his name was removed from the substitute list on May 19, 2004.

1 3. During the evenings of May 14 and 15, 2004, Mr. Gilmore furnished alcohol to male
2 North Bend High School students while coaching the boy's golf team in Sunriver, Oregon.

3 4. During the evenings of May 14 and 15, 2004, Mr. Gilmore engaged students in poker
4 games and won approximately \$30 from North Bend High School students while coaching the
5 boy's golf team in Sunriver, Oregon.

6 5. On September 24, 2004, Mr. Gilmore was convicted for Furnishing Liquor to a Minor
7 in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County.

8 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

9 Items 3 and 4 above constitute Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of OAR 584-020-
10 0040(4) and 584-020-0040(4)(o), as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c). Mr. Gilmore's
11 criminal conviction for Furnishing Liquor to a Minor constitutes Gross Unfitness in violation of
12 OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c). The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is
13 based upon ORS 342.175.

14 ORDER

15 The Commission hereby revokes the Oregon Basic Teaching License issued to Lance
16 Michael Gilmore.
